Summer Session 2012

ELEMENTARY TEACHING POSITIONS

- 1. *ESL*** **July 10-27 9:00am-12:15pm**
These courses provide students at the elementary level with the opportunity for English language improvement with a focus on speaking, listening, reading and writing skills. Previous teaching experience related to balanced literacy is required.
 - Salary: \$2025 (includes teacher prep time) per course
- 2. *Primary & Intermediate Skill Development*** **July 10-27 9:00am-12:15pm**
These classes provide primary and intermediate students with help to improve their basic skills in Mathematics and Language Arts. Instructors will be responsible for delivering a course that adapts teaching strategies which will be compatible with the learning style of the students. Activities should be innovative, motivating and challenging.
 - Salary: \$2025 (includes teacher prep time) per course
- 3. *Academic Enrichment*** **July 10-27 9:00am-12:15pm**
These classes will provide students with unique opportunities to further enrich academic skills. Courses include Writers' Workshop, Math Workshop, Surprising Science, Fun in the Sun with Reading, and Essay and Report Writing. Instructors will be responsible for delivering a course that adapts teaching strategies which will be compatible with the learning style of the students. Activities should be innovative, motivating and challenging.
 - Salary: \$2025 (includes teacher prep time) per course
- 4. *K-Grade 1 & Grade 3-4 Transition***
English and French **July 10-27 9:00am-12:15pm/12:45pm-4:00pm***
These courses provide students entering Grade 1 and Grade 4 in the fall with an introduction to related course work and expectations. Students will develop literacy and numeracy skills and strategies to enhance their learning experiences at their new grade level. Students must have completed Kindergarten and Grade 3 respectively. Courses will be offered in the morning or afternoon sessions.
 - Salary: \$2025 (includes teacher prep time) per course
