#### Refunds for Courses requiring a Fee

A \$35 registration fee will be retained for all requested refunds for courses requiring tuition fees. Requests for refunds must be made in writing and include original receipt.

**JULY 7: FINAL DAY FOR REFUNDS** 

A refundable \$100 textbook deposit is required at time of registration for **ALL** grade 8-12 academic courses (regular, preview and advance credit courses).

## Summer Session Secondary

## Are you eligible

A limited number of academic courses are funded by the BC Ministry of Education making them tuition-free for eligible students who meet the following criteria. Full attendance is required.

There is no course fee for academic courses if you meet **all** of the following criteria:

- you are under 19 years (born after June 30, 1996)
- you are a Canadian Citizen, permanent resident or convention refugee
- you attended a BC school in the 2014-15 school year
- you and your parent/guardian currently reside in BC
- you have a BC Personal Education Number (PEN)
- you have completed the prerequisite course or obtained a *Permission to Attend* form from your home school

#### **Non-Burnaby School District Students**

Students who do not attend a district school must register in person. A PEN number is required for a tuition-free course for BC students. The following documents are also required:

#### 1. Proof of residence (2 required)

- Completed Agreement of Purchase; or
- Residential Tenancy Agreement; or
- Property tax notice; or
- Hydro/utility bill; or
- BC Driver's License; or
- Documentation from a government agency or financial institution

#### AND

#### 2. Proof of citizenship (1 required)

- Canadian Birth Certificate; or
- Citizenship card with photo ID; or
- Citizenship and Immigration Canada (CIC) documentation

#### AND

#### 3. Copy of the student's most recent school marks

- Student's most recent report card; or
- Transcript of academic record

IMPORTANT: Summer Session students must present their final report card to their Summer Session teacher by Tuesday, July 7.
